**Report Development Notes:** <sup>a</sup> FTE (full-time equivalent) = Fall Undergraduate hours divided by 15, graduate-1 (master's level) hours divided by 12, and graduate-2 (doctor's level) hours divided by 9. The divisors 15, 12 and 9, are considered the standard credit course load taken by a full-time student at the undergraduate, master's and doctor's level respectively.

Effective FA 2010, the Professional Health FTE was added to the graduate count due to changes from the U.S. Dept of Education.
