What is the Alabama Credential Registry (ACR)?

- The ACR is a primary component of the Alabama Talent Triad (ATT) which includes the following components to comprise a full-scale talent marketplace ecosystem:
 - Validated Learning & Employment Records (LERs) for all Alabama students via ATT Digital Learner wallets
 - 2. Alabama Credential Registry with Compendium of Valuable Credentials
 - 3. Skilled based job generator
- Breaks programs down into course level micro-credentials to power/inform the ATT Recommendations* for personalized learning pathways and jobs
- Sets the stage to support Validated LERs for your students via "Add Credentials > Sync from Provider" in the Alabama Talent Triad as well as more transparent and efficient recognition of prior learning.
